Remarks:

- 1. The university requires students to achieve basic competencies and meet graduation requirements.
- 2.Students are required to take 4 hours of Service Education courses (0 credit) during their first year.
- 3. Students shall take 16-24 credits each semester in the 1st and 2nd academic years, 9-24 credits each semester in the 3rd academic year, and 16-27 credits each semester in the 4th academic year.
- 4.Minimum credits required for graduation are 128 credits (84 required credits and at least 44 elective credits). (including the interdepartmental elective credits).
- 5.No fewer than 30 professional elective credits are required with the exclusion of credits for inter-disciplinary programs. Note: Inter-departmental elective credits are transferable.
- 6. The elective courses are subject to change if necessary.
- Students are required to take one-year internship according to the regulations approved by the Committee of Internship at the department.
- 8. Students may choose to take courses in one of the three modules.

 Module A:Hotel F/O; Module B: Hotel F & B, and Other Profit-Generating Services;

 Module C:Hotel Administration. Practice of Hotel Operation, Food & Beverage Services, and Hotel Marketing are offered to Class A in the 1st semester and Class B in the 2nd semester of the 2nd academic year.
- 9. The sign # indicates courses offered for the AHLA certificate examination.
- 10.Students having graduated from a foreign country, including Hong Kong and Macau, with the equivalent of the second year of high school study of the ROC's high school sophomore level, or with a high school equivalent degree, need to take 140 credits including 80 compulsory credits, and at least 60 elective credits (including inter-departmental elective credits), while elective professional course credits shall not be fewer than 48. The program can be extended up to 3 academic years.
