Remarks:

- The university has established regulations on basic competencies and graduation requirements for students.
- Students must complete labor education (0 credits, 4 hours) in both semesters of the first academic year.
- In the first three years, students must take 16-30 credits per semester, and in the fourth year, they must take 9-30 credits per semester.
- Minimum graduation credits: 128 credits, consisting of:
 - 86 compulsory credits
 - 42 elective credits (including inter-departmental electives, with at least 26elective credits taken within the department).
- Students who have graduated from foreign high schools, including those in Hong Kong and Macau, with an academic level equivalent to the second year of senior high school in Taiwan and who are admitted to the university under equivalent academic qualifications must complete a minimum of 140 credits, consisting of:
 - 86 compulsory credits
 - 54 elective credits (including inter-departmental electives, with at least 38 elective credits taken within the department).
 - The study period may be extended for up to three years.
- Courses marked with △ are signature courses of the School of Humanities and Social Sciences. Students from the School of Humanities and Social Sciences must complete 8 credits and pass the courses to receive a certification issued by the school. (For students from other departments, these courses may count as inter-disciplinary elective credits.)
- Students who complete any module with at least 12 credits will receive a module certificate.
 - ⊕: Foreign Language and Education Module.
 - ⊙: Business Foreign Language Module.
- The listed elective courses are for reference only and may be adjusted based on actual circumstances.
