 1. The university has established regulations on basic competencies and graduation requirements for students.

 2. Students must complete labor education (0 credits, 4 hours) in both semesters of the first academic year.

 3. In the first three years, students must take 16-30 credits per semester, and in the fourth year, they must take 9-30 credits per semester.

 4. Minimum graduation credits: 128 credits (including 20 inter-departmental erecitis); compulsory credits: 86 credits.

 5. Students who have graduated from foreign high schools, including those in Hong Kong and Macau, with an academic level equivalent to the second year of senior high school in Taiwan and who are admitted to the university under equivalent academic qualifications must complete a minimum of 140 credits (including 20 inter-departmental credits).

 (1) Compulsory credits: 86 credits.

 (2) Elective credits: 4c credits (including inter-departmental electives), of which at least 38 elective credits must be taken within the department.

 3) The study period may be extended for up to three years.
