Remarks:

- 1. Minimum graduation credits: 128 credits, including 45 elective credits (at least 33 credits must be taken within the department, while the remaining may be inter-departmental).
- 2. In the first three years, students must take 16–30 credits per semester, and in the fourth year, they must take 9–30 credits per semester.
- 3. The listed elective courses may be adjusted based on actual circumstances.
- 4. Students must comply with the university's "Regulations on Basic Competencies and Graduation Requirements."
- Off-campus internship courses should be conducted in accordance with relevant implementation guidelines.
 Students are required to complete labor education once per semester in their first academic year (0 credit/2 hours).
- 7. Students who have graduated from foreign high schools, including those in Hong Kong and Macau, with an academic level equivalent to the second year of senior high school in Taiwan, and who are admitted to the university under equivalent academic qualifications, must complete a minimum of 140 credits and may extend their study period by up to three years.
