Remarks:

- 1. The university requires students to achieve basic competencies and meet graduation requirements.
- 2. Students are required to take 4 hours of Service Education courses (0 credit) during their first year.
- 3. Undergraduate students shall take 16-30 credits every semester for the 1st and 2nd academic years and 9-30 credits every semester for the 3rd and the 4th academic year.
 Students who pursue minors, dual degrees, or concentration programs, can reach the maximum 30 credit hours in those particular programs each semester.
- 4.Minimum credits required for graduation are 128 credits (85 required credits and at least 43 elective credits). (including the interdepartmental elective credits). Students who plan to be certified preschool teachers should apply for enrollment examination held by the Center for Teacher Education and complete an extra 20 required credits.
- 5.No fewer than 31 professional elective credits are required with the exclusion of credits for interdisciplinary programs.
- 6. "Young Child Development (I)" is a prerequisite for "Young Child Development (II)". "Project Practices(I)" is a prerequisite for "Project Practices(II)" \circ
- 7. Two of the three subjects("Preschool Curriculum Design", "Preschool Teaching Materials and Methods I" and "Preschool Teaching Materials and Methods II") are a prerequisite for "Practicum in Early Childood Care and Education".
- 8. "Practicum in Early Childhood Care and Education" is required for graduation, students with exceptions approved by the "Departmental Curriculum Committee" should take 9 alternative credits.
- Before graduation, students must take either "After-School Programs: Theories and Practice" or "Infant and Toddler Programs: Theory and Practice", and pass.
- 10. Before graduation, students must take "Young Children Industry Practicum"
- (i.e.,Infant Care, Children's Art, Early Intervention,or After-school Child Care Industry) $^{\circ}$ and pass. 11. Students having graduated from a foreign country, including Hong Kong and Macau, with the equivalent
 - the second year of high school study of the ROC's high school sophomore level, or with a high school equivalent degree, need to take 140 credits including 85 compulsory credits, and at least 55 elective credits (including inter-departmental elective credits), while elective professional course credits shall not
- 12. The elective courses are subject to change if necessary.
