- Students are required to take 52 credits to meet the graduation requirement which are
 - Students shall take at least 20 credits of preschool teacher training courses
 - 1-1 Education Basic subject: 3 courses 6 credits
 - 1-2 Teaching methods: 3 courses 6 credits
 - 1-3 Educational Practice Curriculums: 4 credits
 - 1-4 Specialized Field Curriculums: 2courses 4 credits
 - Students shall take at least 32 credits of 'Professionnal Knowledge and Competence in Early Childhood Educare Programme' which were certified by 'Regulation of Credits Transmission of Early Childhood Education and Care Programs' and have the certification from programmes above.
 - Students are required field learning for 54 hours which are included learning practice, remedial teaching, learning guilding and service learning.
 - The credits of field practicum in the third year is counted additionally.
