Dissertation/Project Writing UP Regulations of Department of Hotel Management and Culinary Creativity

- 1. The dissertation/project was written primarily for final year undergraduate students as one credit of compulsory course. Failed in this course will not be graduated in the program.
- 2. Everyone's dissertation/project is grouped as a 4-5 person team with a supervisor. The research streams are divided into hotel room and front office operation area, food and beverage management area, and hotel executive back-office area. Check with your supervisor if you are unsure about any aspect of the research area of your work.
- The cost happened in the working project will be paid by students themselves. Payments of the project and other relevant issues could be discussed with the supervisors if necessary.
- 4. The completed work will be evaluated by judges who will be grouped from the department teaching faculties. Each team will be asked to attend the final school oral presentation and poster publication. The oral and poster presentation of student projects will be rated as 20% of creativity, 20% of chapters of content, 20% of team spirits, and 40% of oral presentation (Q&A). The final grading of each team before announcing will be discussed by the school teaching faculties. The grading of oral and poster publication will be occupied 30% of total grades. The supervisors will be grading the rest 70% of the total grades.
- 5. Each team has to hand out the final project print out and soft copy to the department executive faculty.
- 6. This legal rule was made and passed by the department meeting in 1998, and will be updated periodically. Meanwhile, this rule is applied to every student afterwards.
