Remarks:

- The university requires students to achieve basic competencies and meet graduation requirements.
- Students are required to take 4 hours of Service Education courses (0 credit) during their first year.
- In the first three years, students must take 16-30 credits per semester, and 9-30 credits per semester in the 4th year.
- Minimum credits required for graduation are 128 credits (78 required credits and at least 50 elective credits).
(including the interdepartmental elective credits)
- No fewer than 38 professional elective credits are required with the exclusion of credits for inter-disciplinary programs.
Note: Inter-departmental elective credits are transferable.
- Students must have skill practice in a senior citizen service organization in the first semester in their senior year.
- The three Field Courses are:
 - ◇ Field A Courses -- Smart Care Management
 - ◇ Field B Courses-- Geriatric Social Work
 - ◇ Field C Course -- Planning for Retired Life.
- Students having graduated from a foreign country, including Hong Kong and Macau, with the equivalent of the second year of high school study of the ROC's high school sophomore level, or with a high school equivalent degree, need to take 140 credits including 78 compulsory credits, and at least 62 elective credits (including inter-departmental elective credits), while elective professional course credits shall not be fewer than 50. The program can be extended up to 3 academic years.
- The elective courses are subject to change if necessary.
