- 7. Students having graduated from a foreign country, including Hong Kong and Macau, with the equivalent of the second year of high school study of the ROC's high school sophomore level, or with a high school equivalent degree, need to take 140 credits including 81 compulsory credits, and at least 59 elective credits (including inter-departmental elective credits), while elective professional course credits shall not be fewer than 47.
