Remarks

1. Minimum credits required for graduation: 33 credits with 9 compulsory credits and 24 elective credits.
2. Courses not on the listed above table can be counted as modules elective credits if approved by members of course planning committees.
3. The inter-institution elective credits are transferable with the approval of academic advisor, but IMM elective course credits shall not be less than 12.
4. Maximum credits for every semester: 16 credits. (not including "Thesis")
5. Students shall take a total 6 credits of "Thesis" course (all 6 credits will be credited following passage of the thesis defense).
6. "Independent Study" is an elective course for students postponing their graduation for another year.
