Professional Norms and Personal Responsibility

in Research Ethics

Unit Introduction

A researcher, in addition to avoiding improper research conduct (such as fabrication, falsification, and plagiarism), should carry out "responsible conduct of research" (or RCR). Under this core principle, many scientific research institutions, associations, and professional journals have established specific research ethical standards and norms to allow researchers in each field to follow the minimum standards for research conduct when conducting their research. These ethical norms, however, primarily rely on self-discipline; researchers are expected to govern their own attitudes and behaviors to comply with research ethics, while avoiding any improper research conduct.

In general, there are four categories of research ethics: professional norms, governmental regulations, institutional policies, and personal responsibility (Steneck, 2007). This unit introduces specific definitions for "professional norms" and "personal responsibility," provides examples of some well-known professional norms of research ethics in the international research community, and explains the categories of research ethics and the researcher's personal responsibility. This unit will provide junior researchers with the basic guidelines needed to maintain ethical research standards.

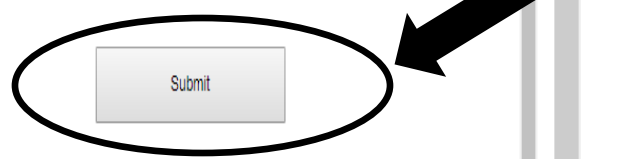

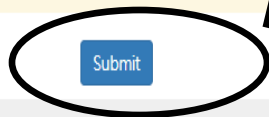
